Competition Information

- Participants must be an undergraduate or graduate student who is an individual enrolled in at least nine (9) credit hours or the number of hours required by an accredited educational institution for full-time status. *Proof of enrollment may be required upon submission of an abstract.*
- Student poster advisors and professors are not considered “student participants” for the proceeding contest information.
- Participants shall submit the following to both kyoshimura@hbws.org (AWWA) and sara@tlcghawaii.com (HWEA):
 - Contest application with project abstract due **December 18, 2020**
 - Presentation slides in PDF format due **January 15, 2021**
 - Recorded presentation due **January 15, 2021**
- Student participants are encouraged to attend a live Q&A to defend their research to the cohort of judges on Wednesday, **February 3, 2021**
- A sign-up link for the live Q&A timeslots will be sent via email to each confirmed participant on Wednesday, January 27 2021, one (1) week prior to the first full day of the 2021 Pacific Water Conference.
- The top three (3) poster board entries related to AWWA subject areas and the top three (3) poster board entries related to HWEA subject areas will be recognized and awarded on Thursday, February 4, 2021.

- **Maximum presentation time: 15 minutes**
- **Live Q&A participation is not required, but recommended for competition scoring.**
- **Recommended presentation recording formats: PowerPoint (ppt), Zoom recording, or mp4 file.**
